Please also note that all direct debits will continue to remain frozen until we can return and therefore no payment will be taken.

Please accept our apologies for the delay in processing your refunds that are still outstanding due to the closure of the Sportspark in March.

If you paid for a Learn2 subscription and have not cancelled your subscription, your refund will be paid to the bank account that we hold on your account. If you have cancelled your subscription, you will be contacted by our Reception team and either, refunded by your original method of payment or your bank details will be requested if you paid in cash.

If you paid for 1-1 swimming lessons, you will be contacted by our Reception team to arrange a refund. This will be paid back to your original method of payment, if you paid by card, or your bank details will be requested if you paid in cash.
